Position Requires:

- Experience in Trauma informed Care is helpful, but not required.

- Collaborate, coordinate, and communicate effectively with families, professionals, and other stakeholders.
- Thorough understanding of the challenges and experiences of family members of individuals with intellectual disabilities and autism.
